


The Calgary Highlanders Regimental Watch To Honour Our History



In April 1910 the people of Calgary proudly formed the 103rd Regiment (Calgary Rifles). At the outset of the Great War, the 103rd contributed the most soldiers to what became the 10th Battalion, Canadian Expeditionary Force. Calgary's fighting men were among the first to encounter chlorine gas at Ypres near an oak plantation at St. Julien known as Kitchener's Wood. When Allied troops broke in the face of poison gas, the 10th was ordered to counter attack at night directly into withering enemy fire. The Allied Commander-In-Chief, General Foch, referred to this action as the "single most gallant act of the war" and it earned soldiers of the Regiment the distinction of wearing a metal oak leaf on each shoulder. The 10th went on to play a significant role during the war, including Canada's victory at Vimy Ridge and the battle for Hill 70, when its soldiers won more medals than any other Canadian combat unit in a single action. The Calgary Highlanders, formed in January 1921, perpetuates the Fighting Tenth.

On 6 July 1944 the Calgary Highlanders landed in Normandy and from that point on took part in every significant action fought by the Canadian Army in Northwest Europe, earning 22 battle honours as the Canadian 5th Infantry Brigade ground its way through Normandy and the Scheldt Estuary before fighting on German soil in the last battles of the war in Europe. The cost of victory was high: the Calgary Highlanders suffered a greater number of casualties than any other infantry battalion in the Canadian Army in the campaign, a direct result of the battalion's repeated role as the 5th Brigade's leading element.

In the peace which has followed, the Regiment has continued to serve Canada globally and at home. Highlanders have been on missions with NATO and the United Nations throughout the world including Cyprus, the Golan Heights, the former Yugoslavia, Cambodia, Congo, Sierra Leone, the Middle East and the war in Afghanistan to which it has contributed mightily.

The Calgary Highlander Commemorative watch has Seiko movements, raised 24K gold plating on its face, a curved crystal, an engraved case back and a designer Speidel leather band offered in black, blue and red in addition to a custom watch band in the striking regimental tartan. The tartan band is cloth on a leather backing. The watch will be delivered in an embossed velveteen collector's box. A significant portion of the watch sales are being directed to the Calgary Highlanders Regimental Association.
